About The Program Objectives



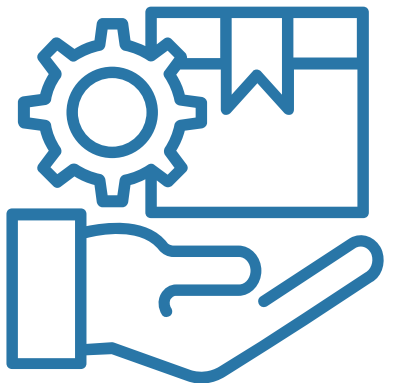
Youth empowerment

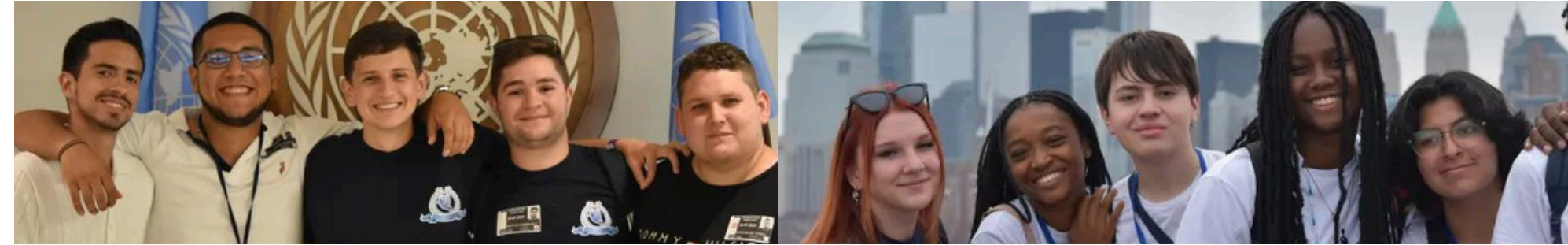
